

NOTICE TO KNOX COUNTY REGISTERED VOTERS

Primary Election Ballots will be mailed on Wednesday, April 22, 2020 to Knox County registered voters as Knox County is a By Mail Election County.

Registered voters who will be absent from their residence (i.e. college students, “snow birds”, etc.) may apply for a ballot to be mailed to a different address than the address at which they are registered or they may apply to appoint an agent to personally pick up their ballot using the form provided below. Another option is that registered voters can vote in the Knox County Clerk’s Office starting April 13, 2020. (PLEASE DO SO OR CONTACT THE KNOX COUNTY CLERK’S OFFICE BEFORE FRIDAY, APRIL 17, 2020 IF POSSIBLE).
