Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, the 3rd day of November, 2020, an election will be held in Knox County, Nebraska. As Knox County is designated as a By Mail Election County, ballots will be mailed to eligible registered voters. Voted ballots must be returned to the Knox County Clerk's Office by 8:00 p.m. on November 3, 2020 in order to be counted. Some races may not appear on your General Election ballot as the candidates are elected by specific subdivisions or districts. Races may appear in a different order on your General Election ballot.

There will be no polling sites in Knox County as Knox County is a By Mail Election County. Early voting ballots will begin to be mailed September 28, 2020 if requested and all other ballots will be mailed to eligible voters on October 14, 2020. Voted ballots are required to be in the Knox County Clerk's Office by 8:00 p.m. on November 3, 2020 to be counted. Postage is provided on the ballot return envelope that will be sent along with the ballots. Ballots can also be hand delivered to the office of the Knox County Clerk or put in the drop box located in the east foyer, which is open 24/7, at the Knox County Courthouse.

The General Election will be for electing candidates to various offices.

The Nebraska Secretary of State will publish a true copy of the title and text of the amendments or referendums once each week for three consecutive weeks preceding the election.
