

# **NOTICE TO VOTERS REGISTERED AS NONPARTISAN**

A registered voter who is not affiliated with a political party and who desires to vote in the Primary Election for the office of United States Senator and/or United States Representative **may request** a partisan primary ballot for any one of the State recognized political parties. §32-912(3)

In addition, this year the Nebraska Democratic Party and the Nebraska Libertarian Party have opened their primary election per §32-912(2) to allow nonpartisan voters to vote in every race where their party is nominating a candidate for a partisan office.

Therefore, voters registered as Nonpartisan will automatically receive by mail a Nonpartisan ballot for the 2020 Primary Election that applies to them. **If a voter registered as Nonpartisan so chooses, they may also request to receive one of the following Nonpartisan Partisan ballots:**

\_\_\_\_\_ **Nonpartisan Republican Ballot** (allows you to also vote for only the Republican races of United States Senate and United States House of Representatives)

\_\_\_\_\_ **Nonpartisan Democratic Ballot** (allows you to also vote for every Democratic partisan race that applies to you)

\_\_\_\_\_ **Nonpartisan Libertarian Ballot** (allows you to also vote for every Libertarian partisan race that applies to you)

**If you select one of the above Nonpartisan Partisan ballots, you will receive a total of TWO ballots by mail for the 2020 Primary Election. PLEASE RETURN THIS FORM BY APRIL 13, 2020 SO THE CORRECT BALLOTS CAN BE MAILED TO YOU ON APRIL 22, 2020.**
