THE FOLLOWING OFFICES AND CANDIDATES ARE NOMINATED WITHOUT OPPOSITION AND WILL AUTOMATICALLY ADVANCE TO THE 2022 GENERAL ELECTION, IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 32-802 AND SECTION 32-811 NEBRASKA REVISED STATUTES, WHERE THE NAMES OF CANDIDATES PROPERLY FILED FOR NOMINATION DO NOT EXCEED TWO CANDIDATES FOR EACH VACANCY TO BE FILLED, THESE CANDIDATES SHALL BE DECLARED NOMINATED AND THEIR NAMES WILL NOT APPEAR ON THE PRIMARY ELECTION BALLOT. THE NAMES WILL AUTOMATICALLY ADVANCE TO THE GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT.
