By Mail Election

This Recall Election will be an election by mail. Each eligible registered voter residing within the City of Crofton will receive a ballot by mail at his/her address as it appears on the voter registration system, therefore no polling places will be open for voting. Ballots will be mailed by the Knox County Clerk’s Office on October 23, 2023. Registered voters residing within the City of Crofton wishing to vote in the Recall Election who will be absent from their residence between October 23, 2023 and November 14, 2023 may contact the Knox County Clerk’s Office to make arrangements for early voting.

Voter Registration Deadlines

1. October 27, 2023 is the last day for online registrations, mail-in registrations, registrar registrations, delivered registrations and agency registration.
2. November 3, 2023 at 6:00 P.M. is the last day for in-person voter registration in the Knox County Clerk’s Office. Any voter who changes information on a current registration or registered to vote after ballots have been mailed but before the in-person registration deadline of November 3, 2023 by 6:00 P.M. will be given a ballot at the time of registration or change.

Ballot Return Deadline

Voted ballots that are sealed in the brown “Return Identification Envelope” may be returned by one of the following means:

1. U.S. Mail: Place \$1.59 postage on the self-addressed brown “Return Identification Envelope” and mail the ballot to the Knox County Clerk, PO Box 166, Center NE 68724.
2. Hand Delivery: Deliver the ballot in person or by agent to the Knox County Clerk’s Office in the Knox County Courthouse, 206 Main Street, Center, Nebraska 68724.
3. Drop Box: The ballot can also be placed in a sealed locked ballot drop box located in the east foyer at the Knox County Courthouse, 206 Main Street, Center, Nebraska, **until 5:00 p.m.** on November 14, 2023.

NOTE: All ballots must be in the possession of the Knox County Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. on Election Day, November 14, 2023.
