

PROCEEDINGS OF THE KNOX COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

A regular meeting of the Knox County Board of Equalization was held in the Boardroom at the Knox County Courthouse in Center, Nebraska on the date of Thursday, May 11, 2023 at 10:01 a.m. Present were Supervisors Martin J. O'Connor District #1, Patrick J. Liska District #2, David L. Pierce District #3, James Sokol, Jr. District #4, Kevin D. Mackeprang District #5, Danny R. Schlote District #6, and James J. Borgmann District #7. Absent was none. Chairman Borgmann presiding.

Chairman Borgmann announced to the public that a copy of the Public Open Meeting Act was posted in the Boardroom.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Niobrara Tribune newspaper, as shown by the Affidavit of Publication attached to these minutes.

Notice of this meeting was simultaneously given to all members and a copy of their acknowledgment and receipt of notice and agenda is attached to these minutes. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was opened to the attendance of the public.

The minutes of the April 27, 2023 meeting were read and approved by Chairman Borgmann.

Deputy Assessor Beckmann met with the Board on the following: 1.) MIPS staff came to give training to the Assessor's Office Staff. Deputy Assessor Beckmann said it has been easy to receive support from MIPS on the new program; 2.) GIS is working on the Knox County GIS program to intergrade the MIPS program information; 3.) Deputy County Attorney Jensen is reviewing the revised Eagleview contract and said it does appear to be acceptable except there was one portion that was confusing so she would like clarification from Ryan Poots with Eagleview. Also, she had researched the Eagleview company and said the company is reputable; 4.) Advertising to fill an office position will not take place at this time; 5.) There are approximately two hundred personal property schedules that have not been filed. Penalties will be assessed.

There was no public comment on agenda items nor on non-agenda items.

Chairman Borgmann adjourned the Knox County Board of Equalization at 10:12 a.m. on May 11, 2023 until 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 25, 2023 for a regular meeting.
